## The Winnebago Story

Although Winnebago began like many companies in the recreational vehicle industry—as an assembler of travel trailers and camper coaches—the comparison ends there. Like its product, the Winnebago story is unique.

Founded in 1958, the company grew gradually in the early 1960s. Then in 1964, fire destroyed the entire production facility in Forest City. At this time management made basic decisions to mass produce motor homes, the fast growing segment of the recreation vehicle business.

Manufacture of motor homes began in 1966 and the company rose rapidly. Encouraged by continuing high demand, Winnebago expanded facilities on a continuing basis until 1973.

Present facilities in Forest City, Iowa, are the world's largest devoted to the manufacture of recreation vehicles and include manufacturing facilities containing 1,700,000 square feet, a warehouse with 550,000 square feet, and corporate and general offices of approximately 150,000 square feet. Total square footage under roof is just over 2,400,000 square feet.

Expansion was based upon a management view that the company could make almost all its own components faster, at lower cost, and with increased quality control. And currently, in facilities combining maximum vertical integration of component manufacture with mass production line techniques, the company's operations are unique in the RV industry. This extensive vertical integration which permits Winnebago to make almost all motorhome components, excluding chassis, engines, electrical power plants and appliances, has important benefits for you.

These benefits enable Winnebago to offer the best value for the money in the motor home field—the number one reason why Winnebago is number one in the RV business.

Through the vertical integration process, raw materials such as aluminum, plastics, steel and fabrics are converted into components designed specifically for motor home application. This perfect mating of design and material in components provides greater durability and more attractive appearance than comparable parts in competitive units.

Underneath is a framework of heavy-gauge steel, with solid angle-steel reinforcing all structural stress points throughout the unit.

Floors, walls, ceiling and motorhome components are anchored to the framework, with extra steel members front to rear. Steel surrounds the driver's compartment and we add additional steel supports to a heavy-duty Dodge chassis.

· For the period of one year from the date of purchase - air compressor, air conditioner (auto), air conditioner (roof), antenna, axles (TT), auxiliary battery (MH), battery (TT), brake assembly (TT), converter, speed control, demand pump, furnace, hitch (TT), LP gas bottle(s), power range hood, pre-finished panelling, range, radio, refrigerator, sink, stereo, vacuum cleaner, gauges, water conditioner, toilet, and water heater.

· For the period of 90 days from the date of purchase-carpet, cushion foam, compartment doors, drainage hose, driver and passenger seats, electrical systems, cushion fabric, fire extinguisher, plastic refrigerator interior door, faucets, light fixtures, plumbing system, switches, shower door, shower
