ALL-ALUMINUM

in the cabover and where the bedslide is located. Every opening is framed with aluminum tubing to make sure these campers are structurally sound in order to handle the rigors of the road as well as off-road adventures.



Each individual component of the structure is hand welded together, and after it is screwed and bolted together, we

take the extra step of welding the individual components together to form a true UNI-BODY construction that will stand the



test of time and provide your family with years of carefree adventures! Our goal is provide the best built, most durable, best value for your investment and this is how we achieve that.

For decades, many entry level truck campers have been built using mostly wood for their structure. That is something you will never find at SOARING



EAGLE CAMPERS. We construct our campers using all-welded, tubular aluminum. The sidewalls, floor, end walls and roof of a Soaring Eagle are ALL crafted from strong, yet



lightweight aluminum, which results in our ADLARs being the best constructed truck campers on the market!

That is important because a lot of our competition laminate their walls with only perimeter aluminum and try to claim that "the strength is in the foam". Don't fall for that. You work too hard for your money to invest it in an inferior product.

BUILT BETTER

The Most Important Aspect of Any Camper is How Well it is Built.
What is Underneath All of the Eye Appeal?



Look at all of this strong, tubular aluminum structure! As part of that structure, each ADLAR is well insulated with a combination of block foam and bubble foil. Then, the interior wall and ceiling coverings as well as our seamless exterior fiberglass are each backed with a composite layer (not thin luan wood like our competition) which resists moisture and adds additional R-value to the camper. The result is a Soaring Eagle Camper ends up being much like a big cooler/ice chest with the structure being unaffected by moisture as it holds its temperatures - both hot and cold - very well.

ATTENTION TO DETAIL

The dinette bases in the ADLAR are constructed of rugged yet lightweight composite material. While this unique dinette structure appears to be overkill compared to the competition's wood and paneling constructed dinettes, it is worth it! They are not only much stronger and more durable, but also feature storage space as well as a built-in battery box. THIS is how you construct a dinette base!

NO MORE COMPLICATED TIE DOWN SYSTEMS! When it comes to securing an ADLAR truck camper in the bed of a truck, it doesn't get much easier than our retractable ratchet strap system. These easy to use straps allow our owners to quickly and easily attach the camper to the tie down points in the bed of the truck.







It's not cheap to put the super-efficient TRUMA Combi furnace and water heater in our camper as Standard in place of a typical RV system.

It's not cheap to use automotive grade foam in our seating and to use a residential style mattress in our bed.

We could make it cheap, but then it wouldn't be a Soaring Eagle Camper!
