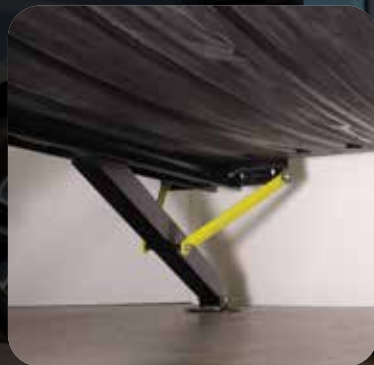

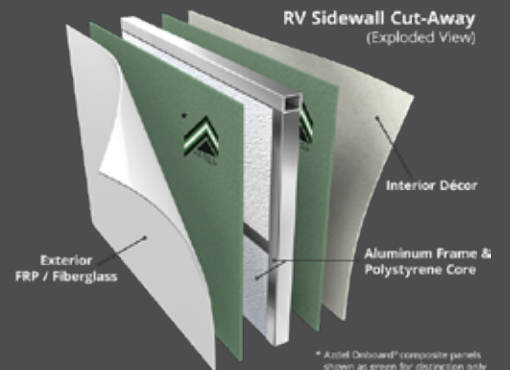

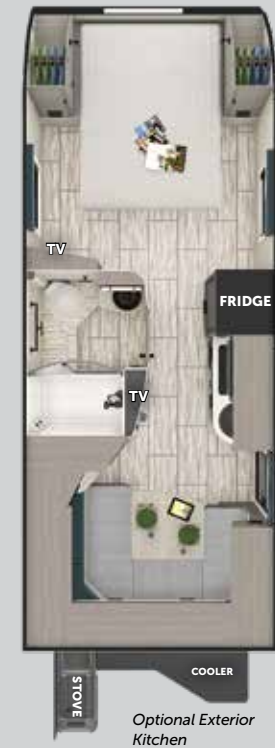

LANCE BUILDS REASONABLY SIZED TRAILERS FOR REAL CAMPERS

JD Power reports, "Approximately 98% of national park campgrounds can accommodate RVs up to 19 feet long. You still have a good selection if your RV is smaller than 25 feet; more than 90% of parks permit that length. The number of available campsites drops if your RV is 29 to 32 feet long, since about 80% of parks will let you in. If you have an RV up to 35 feet long, just over 70% will have room for you. Only about half of all national parks have sufficient space for RVs over 37 feet in length. Even if the park you plan on visiting allows larger RVs, they may have only a few slots available to accommodate them.

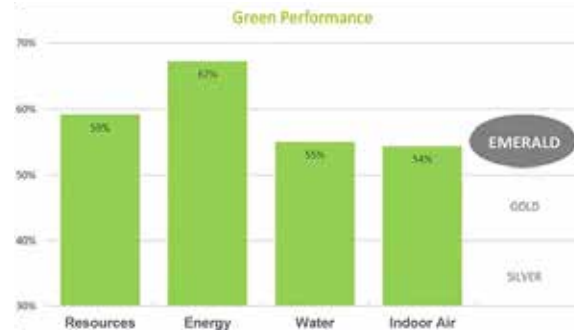
