


40 PLUS YEARS OF BUILDING POP-UP CAMPERS IN THE USA



The base model standard features are a good starting point for most customers. This will include items like the cabover bed, the roll over couch, interior lights, windows, a stainless steel sink with pressurized water system, propane stove, fresh water tank, propane tanks, and more...

INTERIOR FEATURES

Seating arrangements have typically been exceptionally challenging in such a small compartment, but we currently have 3 different floor plans available that make great use of the interior space and also provide a good amount of storage as well. The Roll Over L-shaped Couch is very comfortable for seating and will also convert into an additional bed. The Side Dinette Seating is very popular for people that enjoy face to face seating as well as a big picture window. The Front Dinette Seating arrangement was answered with a pair of seats divided by a swivel table that also folds down into an additional bed. The swivel dinette table provides a durable work surface for writing, reading, or laptop activity, as well as mealtime and snacking enjoyment.

- Countertops are sturdy Formica on American plywood. We never use Chinese plywood, particle board, MDF, OSB, or other flimsy material in the construction of your camper.
- Vinyl flooring, while perceived as ordinary, is lightweight, durable, easy to clean and only the best quality brands and product lines are installed.








- Curtain and upholstery fabrics are chosen not just for quality, but cleanability as well (we offer a variety of fabric colors available to choose from).
- Stainless steel sink with on-demand electric water pump.
- Each floor plan has storage space for a small porta potti (not shown).

- Drawers & cupboards are provided for storage of your smaller items.
- 7. Two burner propane cook stove.
- 1" inch foam insulation in the walls & roof of the camper (not shown).
- Forced air furnace with digital thermostat available to keep you warm on cold nights.



SIMPLE, DURABLE AND LIGHT WEIGHT

The Four Wheel Camper is a lot more developed and refined than it was back in 1972, but the basic concept hasn't changed at all. The camper must observe three basic principles: light weight, durability, simplicity. Aluminum framing and skin keeps the camper light and durable. Understated cabinetry, made of American made maple and fir plywood with UV cured finish, provides lightweight simplicity and a greater feeling of spaciousness in a very compact living space. Decorative design elements are kept to an absolute minimum to reduce weight and increase durability. These three simple, yet complex goals, provide a very small niche in the camper marketplace unlike other brands of truck campers. Whereas larger, more complex truck campers provide amenities and large living spaces, Four Wheel Campers embrace the ability to literally go camping in comfort anywhere your truck can go safely and with relative ease.

The basic idea is a fairly simple, but very strong cage like aluminum frame fabricated from aluminum tube and extruded channel. Much like an airplane frame, it has the ability to flex, providing greater strength and durability, therefore longer life and the ability to handle the torque experienced on mountain and desert roads, far away from pavement. Optimum off road capability demands the lowest center of gravity. The minimal height over the cab of the truck is essential, and as much weight as possible is on the floor of the camper. That's why the water tank and propane tanks have migrated to the floor in recent years. Our roof lifting mechanism is like no other in the market. Instead of a complex lift arm apparatus with difficult linkage and geometry, our campers use a simple articulated lift panel at the front and back with spring loaded piano hinges, providing a shear wall effect for exceptional stability in high winds. This also provides support for a substantial snow load on the roof.


- Our campers are very light weight. Most models will average between 1000 and 1200 lbs.
- We offer a full 5 year warranty on the aluminum camper frame, the soft sided pop-up portions of the camper, and the roof with one piece aluminum surface.
- The campers have a very low profile design for reduced wind drag, increased fuel economy, and greater stability.
- >>> Each camper is built with durability and utility in mind.
- Many of our customers use their camper for both off road as well as on road use.
- We have been building campers for over forty years.



Over the years Four Wheel Campers have evolved into a more modern and comfortable product. We have stayed true to the basic concept and system by system the campers and floor plans have improved. The campers do NOT contain any particle board or press wood, the electrical system was completely redesigned, and components ranging from foam to fabrics to plumbing fittings were improved. The frame is stronger than ever. Lessons learned from world travelers, and especially Baja California experiences have

taught us where the frame needed improvement. The camper is truly a work in progress. New materials are constantly researched and studied to lighten, strengthen, and improve performance. The future brings more improvement, much of it suggested by owners who use the product on a regular basis, and many who camp away from the mainstream in harsh and punishing conditions. We have a very strong following in the marketplace and have a reputation for building campers with the strongest camper frames.

Front Dinette Model



Face to face seats at the front of the camper feature wide cushions which convert to a comfortable additional bed, with storage compartments underneath. The swivel table provides an excellent work station as well as a dining arrangement. The "split" galley provides excellent storage capacity. This is the only interior available with a built in cassette toilet, but alternatively accommodates a porta potti as well.




The base model interior design has been improved to a roll over seat back making into an additional bed. The benefit to this standard offering is a great storage capacity under the seat. Side by side seating on the couch is quite ample, with the knock down three piece table providing a work or dining surface. A storage cabinet over the seat provides added storage capacity.

Side Dinette Model



Face to face seating with the large picture window presents an open feeling with the flexibility of the swivel table offering a work and dining surface which coverts to added sleeping space. Storage under the seat, as well as corner and upper cabinets, provide added capacity to the galley. The center passageway allows freedom of movement without interfering with the fellow traveler seated at the dinette.

Empty Shell Model




The shell model is intended for those who need the most basic accommodation of a dry shelter with comfortable sleeping quarters. The camper is standard with large window, vent, mattress, and lights. Options include seating, forced air furnace, fan, stove, and an excellent selection of additions to complete the camper build out.

- A built in cassette toilet is also available on campers equipped with the front dinette seating floor plan. (items not shown)
- 11. Side wall storage cabinet.
- A sturdy screen door now comes as standard equipment on all camper models.
- 13. 12 Volt accessory outlets for powering small items or recharging your cell phone.
- Queen sized cabover bed comes with all camper models (approx. size).
- Powered roof vent fan(s) available for improved air circulation or cooling on hot days (item not shown).
- The basic Ice Box comes as standard equipment, but we also have 5 different refrigerator/freezer upgrades available.
- Fire extinguisher, smoke detector, propane sensor & carbon monoxide sensors installed for your safety.




THE LIGHTEST WEIGHT, LOWEST PROFILE CAMPER IN THE INDUSTRY

- Four corner mechanical camper jacks are available to make it easy for the customer to load & unload the camper from their truck.
 One really nice feature about these jacks is that they are removable so you can leave them at home while you are traveling. (Item not shown)
- Propane tanks supply the propane to run your camper appliances like the refrigerator, furnace and hot water heater. Two tanks eliminate running out of propane with no back up.
- Four generous sized windows with screens are built in to the soft pop-up sides on each camper. This allows for excellent light and ventilation to the interior of the camper (item not shown).
- The screen door provides excellent ventilation and helps to keep the bugs out.
- A hot water outside shower is available for your convenience to be able to rinse off after a long day, do your dishes outside, rinse down the kids, or clean up your dog before getting into the camper at night.
- Two different styles of roof racks are available, giving you the ability to carry bulky items on your camper roof like surf boards, a canoe, kayaks, or miscellaneous gear. (Item not shown)

- 7. The solar panel option for the camper roof is becoming more popular. This will automatically help to better keep your camper battery(s) recharged. As long as the sun is shining on the panel, it will be recharging the battery(s) inside your camper.
- 8. LED rear flood lights are available if you have the need for additional, bright lighting behind your truck. These work well for setting up camp at night, helping to hook up a trailer, or launching your boat into the lake on a dark morning.
- The rear porch light comes standard on all campers and will help you to safely get in & out of the camper at night.
- The rear awning and the side awning can be a good choice for the customers that desire additional shade coverage or basic shelter from the rain. (Item not shown)
- The 120v shore power outlet will give you the ability to plug your camper into the electricity at your favorite campsite or use a generator when you need an extra boost of power.
