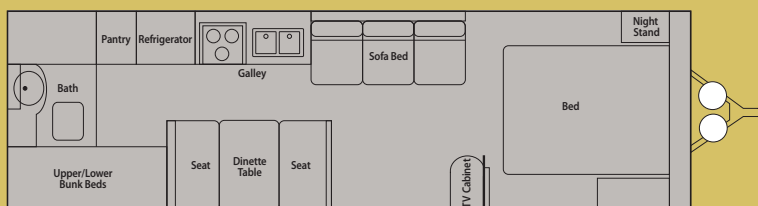
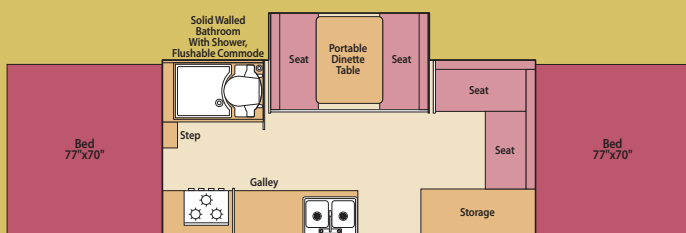

## SUPERIOR OUTDOOR COOKING

We know that part of enjoying the great outdoors is great food prepared outdoors. In recent years, the trend in RV outdoor cooking was the barbecue grill, but experienced campers tell us they prefer the superior versatility and efficiency of a high-pressure outdoor stove. Americana, Highlander, and Evolution (exc. Cobalt) now feature a separate high pressure outdoor stove standard. The Destiny series (exc. Taos and Sedona) features a combination indoor/outdoor low pressure stove standard.

## SUPERIOR FLOOR/BED CONSTRUCTION

To provide long-term durability, we know to use only high quality one-piece Weyerhaeuser Structurwood®. Some competitors boast of using plywood, but look closely—you'll likely see voids, knotholes, and thin stapled-on splices that are prone to squeaks and separation. And some competitors want you to think floor undercoating is beneficial, but

- We reinforce every bed with a full-perimeter aluminum frame and support channels, and we rate them to 1,100lbs capacity (750lbs on Taos and Cobalt).
- All Fleetwood beds feature self-storing support legs that set up easily and cannot be misplaced or lost. Look closely – most competitors use detached poles – like tent poles, they must be preassembled and stored separately.
- Our mattresses feature a comfort-engineered polyester fiber that is hypoallergenic and comfortably soft and supportive. Kick off your shoes and take a rest.
- Some competitors boast of heated mattresses. We do not believe electric mattresses are practical for the rigors of camping use.

## SUPERIOR GALLEY & FURNITURE DESIGN

We know you want your camping trailer's interior to be comfortable and appealing. We also know you need it to be practical and durable. Over 40+ years of building camping trailers, we've become experts in combining these wants and needs.

- For 2008, every Fleetwood galley now features our exclusive seamless-edged countertops (exc. Taos, Sedona, and Cobalt). Look closely and you'll see a seamless surface of durable laminate that provides superior moisture resistance and long-term good looks. Americana, Highlander, and Evolution also feature this same seamless laminate on their tables and hutch tops (exc. Cobalt).
- Every Fleetwood interior features appealing yet practical surfaces that conceal minor scuffs and scrapes.
- Our Highlanders feature a permanent no-set-up-required galley. Look closely, and you'll see that unlike many competitors, we've positioned the faucet where it need not be disassembled before closing down the trailer.
- Americana and Evolution (exc. Cobalt) feature our patented Swing Level® galley that permits no-tip drawer storage in the upper cabinet. Competitors' knock-offs often don't work as well as our design.
- Destiny and Cobalt models feature a flip-over galley that, unlike most competitors, includes a bottom so the upper cabinet can remain packed with supplies.
- Americana, Highlander, and Evolution dinette seats also feature durable painted metal frames.

## SUPERIOR CONFIDENCE OF BRAKES ON EVERY TRAILER

We know that being able to stop a trailer is just as important as being able to tow it, so every trailer we make features electric trailer brakes – standard. Why do many competitors think brakes should be optional?

- Fleetwood uses only five-bolt wheels. Some competitors still use four-bolt wheels.
- We use only EZ Lube axles that permit easy maintenance.
- We use only slipper leaf spring suspensions because they distribute axle forces over a larger frame area and provide trouble-free reliability.

## SUPERIOR LIFT SYSTEM

We know that a folding camping trailer's lift system must survive exposure to elements. That's why our lift posts are clearly visible, because they're clearly superior. Try to find our competitors' lift posts – they're concealed behind awkward tent flaps to keep them out of sight and hopefully out of the elements.

- We manufacture our own high quality stainless steel posts and use aircraft grade stainless steel cables. Competitors' lift posts are just plated steel tubes with springs inside – which means they can rust if left exposed to the elements.
- Fleetwood lift posts divert rainwater harmlessly to the ground. Competitors' lift posts channel rainwater to the springs, which can then rust.
- The Fleetwood lift system is user friendly, with no need for a warning cable. When raising their roofs, most competitors require you to visually monitor a warning cable to avoid the serious damage that can be caused by over-cranking their lift system.
- The Fleetwood lift system is dependable and requires no safety posts. After raising their roofs, many competitors require you to install safety posts.
- Fleetwood engineers and builds its proprietary lift system, with independent cables for each lift post. Many competitors use outsourced lift systems that rely on a single master cable to operate their system. Damage this one cable, and your camper cannot be used.
- Fleetwood's Posi-Lock feature allows you to stop and start cranking without fear of kick-back or free-fall.



## SUPERIOR ROOF CONSTRUCTION

We know the true measure of a camping trailer roof is its ability to provide everyday peace of mind – whether the trailer is being used or being stored out of doors and unattended. No other folding camping trailer manufacturer has built more or knows more about camping trailer roofs than Fleetwood.

- Americana, Highlander, and Evolution (exc. Cobalt) series roofs feature a cambered, one-piece front to rear fiberglass skin, and full-length aluminum rails that integrate our exclusive roof rack tracks.
- Destiny roofs feature an aluminum skin folded along all four edges for added strength without side seams. This roof has approximately half the horizontal seam length of most competitive roofs.
- Look closely at competitors' roofs...they say they're seamless – but they clearly aren't.
- We do not compromise the integrity of our roofs with a vent because we know the plastic dome and the additional screws and caulking are potential sources of leaks and damage when not properly maintained – especially during off-season storage.

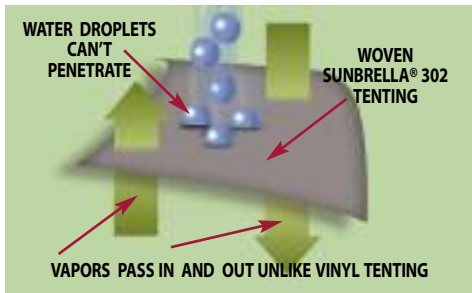

We know a folding camping trailer's tent is comparable to foul weather outerwear – like a mountain climber's parka. That's why our tents feature high performance qualities like inherent water repellency, breathable comfort, and durability. Fleetwood has used Sunbrella 302® woven acrylic tent fabric since 1992, and Sunbrella® is the world's number one selling marine fabric. Because it's woven, Sunbrella breathes, so it doesn't trap heat and moisture like vinyl. Look closely at competitors' tents and you'll see they use unbreathable vinyl coated fabric. Maybe that's why they use roof vents – a potential source of leaks when not properly maintained – especially during outdoor storage. And some competitors even use old-fashioned canvas behind their window screens for breathability. There is no canvas in a Fleetwood tent.



- Sunbrella 302®, is formulated to meet or exceed all FMVSS302 federal standards for flammability.
- Sunbrella 302® is inherently water resistant and requires no periodic treatments.
- Sunbrella 302® resists mildew, dry rot, fading and cracking, and is hypoallergenic.
- Our tents are sectionalized for easier and less costly repair or replacement.
- For easy cleaning, we use vinyl coated fabrics only where dirt is likely to accumulate.

We know camping trailers get towed over rough roads, and require a flexible yet strong metal structure – like a bridge or airplane. That's why only Fleetwood uses a proprietary superstructure that combines a heavy duty tubular steel chassis, thick aluminum upper body rails, up to eleven steel bulkheads, and riveted exterior body panels. And our interior walls are designed to “float”, which allows trailer flex without risk of the interior furniture pulling loose. Most competitors use a lighter duty C channel chassis, thin aluminum rails, and laminated sidewalls assembled with glue, screws and staples – no way to build an over-the-road trailer.

- All models feature galvanized steel body panels riveted to the trailer's aluminum and steel structure.
- Destiny, Americana, and Highlander steel body panels feature the durable Krystal Kote® finish for a smooth automotive appearance.
- Evolution steel body panels are deeply textured for added strength and the ability to conceal nicks and dents.
- Americana series front and rear body panels are thermoformed of impact resistant TPO.
- Destiny, Highlander, and Evolution bodies feature brightly polished diamond plate accents.
- Americana models with storage boxes feature our proprietary seamless storage box that can be hosed out and drained with no damage to the trailer. Most competitors rely on wooden storage boxes.
