INTRODUCING THE 2006 WINNEBAGO VIEW.

From the moment you lay eyes on the View, you know you've found a motor home like no other. Whether it's the exterior styling, cab, lounge or galley, you'll see innovations that maximize function and style at every turn. Check out the interior cabinetry featuring curved lines that not only look great, but also increase available storage space. A stainless steel galley sink is sized to accommodate large pans with ease. The View's interior climate is just as inviting, with day/night pleated shades, floor-ducted heat and ceiling-ducted air conditioning. Choose the available heat pump and take the chill off a cool morning without using LP.

The skylight — another unique View feature — opens as a fresh air vent complete with retractable screen and sun shade. The dinette features comfortable seating for four as well as a child-seat tether in the forward-facing seat (23J only), and it easily converts to a comfortable bed. A 15" LCD TV with DVD player is mounted above the dinette for your viewing pleasure. The TV even retracts into the overhead when not in use (23J only).

Don't let the open layout fool you; there's no shortage of available storage in the View. There are large overhead cabinets with handy open shelves below, easy-to-access under dinette storage, underbed storage in the 23J and even expandable storage in the rear wardrobe of the 23H.





A NEW KIND OF MOTOR HOME.

The View differs from many Class C motor homes in that it gets its power from a 2.7 liter Mercedes-Benz diesel engine. The 5-cylinder turbo-diesel is remarkably quiet, delivering both consistent power and diesel fuel efficiency. An electronically controlled automatic transmission and power rack-and-pinion steering give the View excellent drivability and a tight turning radius. Four-wheel ABS disc brakes with automatic skid control provide added peace of mind on slippery roads. Getting in the View is a breeze too, thanks to cab doors that open nearly 90 degrees.

The living area is also easy to get to, thanks to the large opening provided by our exclusive cutaway chassis design, coupled with the spacious (49" x 75") overhead bunk that easily flips up and out of the way. Or you can choose the front overhead storage cabinet on the 23J floorplan.



NEW FOR THE KITCHEN AND BATH.

Modern design influences are also apparent in the galley's beautiful curved cabinet doors with satin nickel hardware. The full-extension drawer slides provide easy access to all your stored items. You'll appreciate the stylish functionality of the Sharp® microwave/convection oven and three-burner range top with storage below. Add the optional cold-water purification system to the galley sink for a refreshing drink of filtered water anytime.

Step into the bath area and you'll notice chrome fixtures; a stainless steel sink; and an innovative retractable shower door. A flexible showerhead makes showering easy, while the removable clothes rod gives you additional storage. More storage space is also available in the mirrored-door medicine cabinet, the vanity cabinet and the wardrobe.

The cab of the View puts all controls within easy reach. State-of-the-art features include a flip-out key that is electronically encoded for anti-theft security. The power door lock remote is built into the handle, eliminating the need for a separate transmitter. A Sirius® satellite-ready, Clarion® AM/FM/CD in-dash radio with wireless remote allows you to enjoy your favorite music or talk radio. When parked, save the engine battery and run the radio on the house batteries by flipping the radio power switch. To make parking easier than ever, choose the available rearview monitor with one-way audio. Creative use of space, such as the storage designed into the driver and passenger doors, is just another example of what sets the View apart.



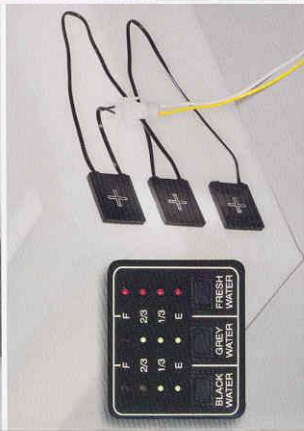
LOOKS AND FEELS GREAT.

The rear mattress is made in two parts, allowing you to slide the outer mattress in, exposing a large underbed storage area that can be accessed from inside or outside the motor home, perfect for bikes, golf bags or other large items. The exterior service center houses many vital motor home utilities, including city water hookup and available exterior

shower with pump switch. Electrical center hookups can also be found here, including the power cord with QuickPort® service connection hatch, cable TV connection and a portable satellite dish hookup.

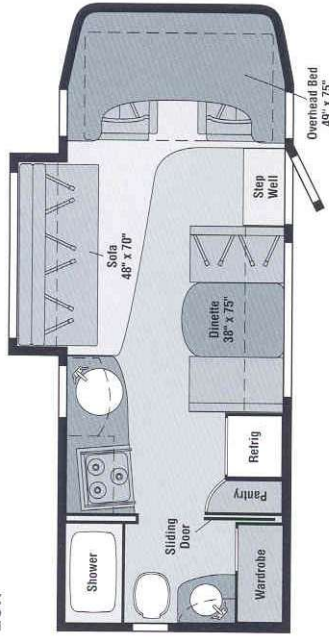

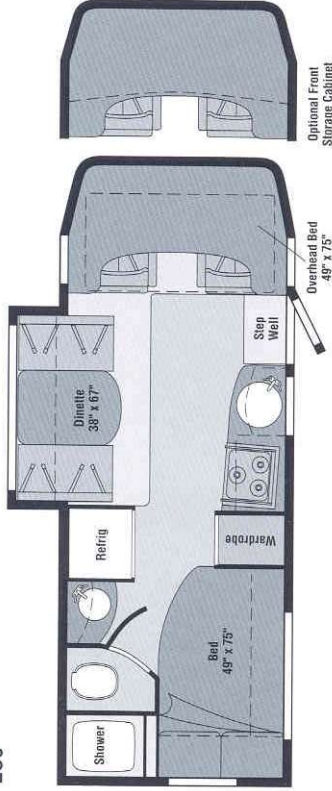

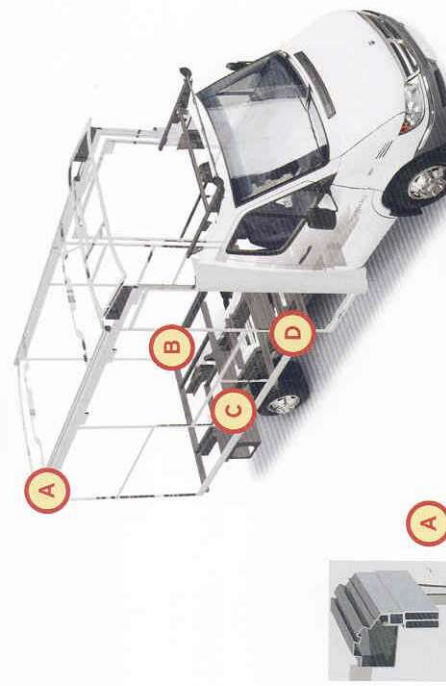

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SUPERSTRUCTURE is the term given to Winnebago Industries' structural motor home design and construction. Rather than a single component, it is the culmination of design integration that incorporates steel and aluminum substructures; welded tubular aluminum floor supports; interlocking joint technology; and Thermo-Panel® floor, roof and sidewalls to form a high-strength, durable vehicle body.

Thermo-Panel manufacturing combines a durable fiberglass exterior panel with welded aluminum support substructures. The substructures are embedded in a high-density, block-foam insulation core to create a strong, durable, yet lightweight sidewall. Just another Winnebago Industries' invention.

A Interlocking joint construction utilizes advanced extruded aluminum structural components to create integrated floor-to-sidewall and sidewall-to-roof joints. This design effectively distributes the weight of the walls and roof, making a stronger and more durable body than competitor designs that rely on screws to carry the weight.

B The foundation substructure assembly is precision-aligned to maximize strength and cross-coach support as well as durability.

C Tubular aluminum floor supports provide a stable base for the floor structure and storage compartments.

D Critical steel components are treated using an advanced electrodeposition coating process that provides superior corrosion protection.



BUILT TO A HIGHER STANDARD.

The View features a crowned, one-piece fiberglass roof skin backed with a 10-year limited parts-and-labor roof skin warranty. Fiberglass offers superior strength, attractiveness and durability compared to rubber roofs found on many competitive models. Over time, rubber roofs are susceptible to chalking, streaking and degradation, and have less puncture and tear resistance than fiberglass.
