# 120-Volt Romex-Identification Information

Part 2 in a 2 part series

This is the second in a two-part series discussing wiring identification information on the 120-volt romex that is now used on the 2007 Winnebago Industries models.

## **Installations Drawings**

The Winnebago Industries wiring installation drawings illustrate wiring placement throughout the motor home. There is even more detail available now.





Figure 7–2007 Adventurer/Suncruiser 120-Volt Load Center

- 1. Refer to Figure 7 and the area circled on the left. Note the "color callouts" on the various circuit breakers. This color I.D. correlates directly with the "color callout text" on the 120-volt romex.
- 2. Refer to Figure 7 and the area circled on the right. Note the metal "knockout" holes in the upper right corner of the load center and identify the romex "exit points" from the breaker panel.

## **Wiring Diagrams**

The Winnebago Industries wiring diagrams provide us with the interconnection of the various appliances and receptacles to the 120-volt load center and EMS or Energy Management Systems "shedder boards," etc.

- 1. Refer to Figure 8 and the top circle at the left. Note the color callouts on the various circuit breakers. This color I.D. correlates with the "color callout text" on the 120-volt romex.
- 2. Refer to Figure 8 and the bottom left circle and circle at right. Starting at the circuit breakers, follow several of the romex and note the wiring AWG callouts (14-2 and 12-2) and the loads supported by the respective romex.
