For hitch maintenance, please lube as follows:



What lube should you use?



The friction surfaces of the head and sockets should be kept clean and well lubricated with a high quality multi-purpose or bearing grease. We recommend Equal-i-zer high performance lubricant.

Where should you lube?



Regularly apply a thin coat (pea sized drop) of lubricant to the sockets. Do not lubricate the L-brackets attached to the trailer frame.

Why should you lube?



The frequency of lube application depends on how often you tow. For most campers, lubing each season works well. If the sockets are dry or starting to rust, then it's time to lubricate.

Lubricating your hitch properly will extend the life of the sockets and the hitch head, and keep your Equal-i-zer on the road for years to come!
