Beginning for the 2015 season and in the future, ANYONE who does NOT pay their site rent IN FULL by June 1 st, for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, will see an increase of \$75 in their Site Rental. This DOES include anyone who makes special arrangements to be paid AFTER June 1 st. Regular missed payment fees and interest still apply. <u>Mail:</u>
