2015 Site Rent Reminder- As a reminder all site rent is now over due. It will soon be time to start taking deposits for 2016. As you know we can not take your deposit if you have any over due balance's on your account for site rent, power or service work. Please come to the office and check to be sure that you are up to date on your account and the power. Payments can be made at either the Blue Haven office or the Plattsburgh office.

<u>EZ Pay Program-</u> Due to the positive response of the EZ PAY program, we will again be offering this as an option. How to determine what your four EZ PAY payments will be 25% of your site rental is due by October 1st and your remaining 3 payments are due in the spring of next year.

- For Example: 2016 site rent = \$1,045.00.
- Fall deposit = \$261.25. Site balance = \$783.75.

• Take \$783.75 and divide by 3 = \$261.25 If you do not pay 25% of your site rental in the fall, there will be a one-time charge of \$45 to activate the EZ PAY program in order to be fair to those who made their fall deposit on time.

2016 Site Rent!

- For Example: 2016 site rent = \$1,045.00.
- Fall deposit none. Late charge = \$45.00.
- Site balance = \$1,090.00.

• Take \$1,090.00 and divide by 3 = \$363.33 This would allow you to activate the EZ PAY Program if a deposit was not made in the fall. EZ PAY FINAL PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

- 2nd payment: Monday, April 1, 2016
- 3rd payment: Wednesday, May 1, 2016
- 4th payment: Saturday, June 1, 2016

Final 3 payments will be as scheduled above, \$5.00 will be added to each payment that is late. If you activate EZ PAY in the spring and did not make a deposit, your 1st payment would be due on April 1st, your second payment is still due by May 1st and the final payment by June 1st. Site contracts NOT paid by June 1st will be charged a \$50.00 late fee, no matter what payment option you choose. Applicable interest fees still apply.

Beginning for the 2015 season and in the future, ANYONE who does NOT pay their site rent IN FULL by June 1 st , for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, will see an increase of \$75 in their Site Rental. This DOES include anyone who makes special arrangements to be paid AFTER June 1 st . Regular missed payment fees and interest still apply. Please refer to Page 2 Rates & Forms of payment in your Policy Book- The policy clearly states that ALL site rentals MUST be paid by June 1 st , no matter what payment plan you choose. You can get an updated page for your policy book from Theresa at the office.

<u>Mail:</u>

 Please stop into the office and check the mail box. The box is full of various guests' . mail, and your mail could be here!

Quiet Hours:

Golf Cart reminders:

- All golf carts MUST obey the post speed limit of 5 mph.
- No one under the age of 16 is allowed to drive a golf cart.
- All golf carts need to have lights to be driven at night.
- Please register the golf carts with the office and have a registered number on them.
- When you sell your golf cart, please remember the new owner must register their new golf cart in their name and get a new number from the office.

<u>Trash:</u>

- Please do not put household trash in the trash cans near the bathhouses and/or common areas.
- There are dumpsters on the South Side beside the pool to be used for trash.
- Please do NOT put wood of any kind in the dumpsters. Just leave it on the ground and our employees with take care of it.
- If you need help finding the dumpsters, any staff member would be glad to show you where they are located.
- You can also go to the office and get a map to show you where the rubbish bins are.
