Site Rent:

All site rent for 2017 must be paid in full by June 1st. While there are only a few accounts left at this point, this number is growing and it is not fair to the rest of the campers that make timely payments. or any of the staff on duty to check overdue balances, and avoid future interest charges. As per our policy, any accounts not current by July 1st, will not be allowed to utilize the campground facilities without approval from John Momot. If site is NOT paid in full by June 1st, a \$50 late fee will apply! Standard missed payment fees/interest still apply! ANYONE who does NOT pay their site IN FULL by June 1st, for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, will see an increase of \$75 in their seasonal site rental. For example, if you are late for the 2016 and 2017 seasons, you will see an increase of \$75 for the 2018 season and so on, until paid on time. 2% of your monthly balance compounded daily of the unpaid balance will be added to total rent due. This replaces the old policy of \$1.00 per day.
