ervations for the week-end. It makes it hard and time consuming for us and our guests coming in if we have to go looking for someone to have a vehicle moved off of a site.



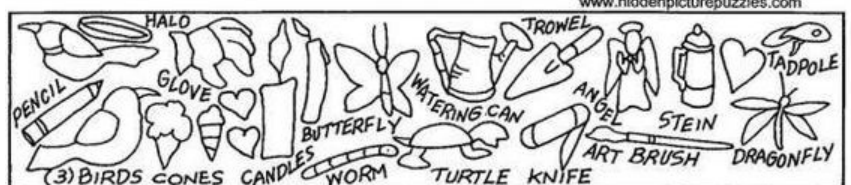
Notice:

We are asking all of our seasonal campers that have pets to please come to the office. We need you to sign the pet policy and give a copy of your updated shot records for our files. Please do this as soon as possible.

Site Rent:

All site rent for 2017 must be paid in full by June 1st. While there are only a few accounts left at this point, this number is growing and it is not fair to the rest of

the campers that make timely payments. Please stop by the Ellenburg office and speak to Theresa or Dave, or the Plattsburgh office and speak to Dennis or any of the staff on duty to check overdue balances, and avoid future interest charges. As per our policy, any accounts not current by July 1st, will not be allowed to utilize the campground facilities without approval from John Momot. If site is NOT paid in full by June 1st, a \$50 late fee will apply! Standard missed payment fees/interest still apply! ANYONE who does NOT pay their site IN FULL by June 1st, for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, will see an increase of \$75 in their seasonal site rental. For example, if you are late for the 2016 and 2017 seasons, you will see an increase of \$75 for the 2018 season and so on, until paid on time. 2% of your monthly balance compounded daily of the un-



paid balance will be added to total rent due. This replaces the old policy of \$1.00 per day.

Notes/Reminders:

- Please stop into the office and check the mail box. There is a lot of mail here and the box is full. Even if you think there won't be anything for you, please check to be sure.
- Please see Dave or Theresa in the office for any park issues so they can arrange to have them taken care of.
- Please before you dig for any reason, cut or trim any trees, make any purchases such as a shed, or build anything, see Dave at the office and refer to the Campground Policy Book.



Please do not put household trash in the trash cans near the bathhouses and our common areas. There are dumpsters on the south side below the pool to be used for trash. If you need help finding the dumpsters, any staff member would be glad to show you where they are located, or you can go to the office and we will give you a map to show you where they are.

- If you would like us to put something in the Gazette it needs to be submitted to us by no later than 12:00pm on Tuesday.
- Please be considerate of your neighbors and remember the quiet hours. Try not to mow lawns early or play loud music too late. Weekdays: Between 10:00pm and 9:00am. Weekends and Holidays: Between 11:00pm and 10:00am.

• Golf Cart Reminders: All golf carts MUST obey the posted speed limit of 5 MPH. No one under the age of 16 is to drive a golf cart. All golf carts need to have lights in order to be driven at night.
