Darts Update - Last week we had 14 players join in the fun! The winning team was Jim, Squatch, and Taylor. Charlie was also the High/Low winner!

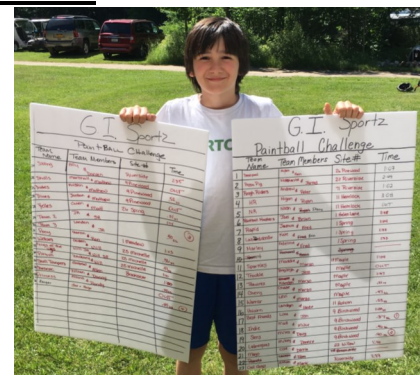
The Voice Contestant to perform
