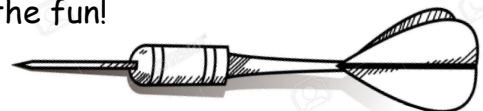
# Scavenger Hunt!

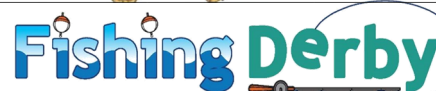
