- Policy Handbook Updates We have been working on streamlining and clarifying our Policy Book and the new versions will be available soon. If you would like a copy e-mailed to you, please call or text us at 518-563-1983.
- Site Improvements Please see Dave with any plans of improving your site. Things to remember before you dig, cut, purchase or build; you need it approved by Dave. This will save any uncomfortable situation between either of us. If you are planning on hiring an outside contractor, see Dave for approval. You can stop by the office to pick up a guideline book which has a lot of information and will answer any questions you may have. - Accounts We have made great strides to keep your accounts current and relevant. Along with these changes, comes a cleaner way to view any balance you may have. See Tim in the office if you have any questions.

Ways to Help You Save Money!

We understand that your money is hard earned and who wouldn't want it to stretch it a bit further.

- Referral Credits: Remember, we offer a referral credit if you introduce a new family to Blue Haven and they rent a site. You would be eligible for a \$150 Site Credit. Details and eligibility requirements are in the Policy Handbook.
- **Price Club** discounted rates apply to Site Rent, parts, and Service rates. Price Club is a program

- to thank customers that patronize our RV Dealership with the purchase of a camper from our dealership. Note: Price Club discounts are good for as long as you own that trailer. A change in the trailer or tenant will call for a new contract.
- Fixed Income Lock-In Agreement This program is intended to serve people who are truly on a fixed income. See our Policy book for more details, but in order to qualify for our "lock in" program, you must provide official documentation, and fall within the terms of ALL of the following:
 - Site contract must be in your name.
 - You must be permanently disabled on a fixed income and/or officially retired on a fixed income.
 - You must be 60 years of age or older.
 - You can not be employed or have other income which includes anyone in the household that is employed.
 - Account most be in good standing.
- Have Site Modifications Approved in Advance This could save a lot of extra expense and
 frustration if some of our infrastructure is
 damaged or if you are in violation of our policies.
- Properly Maintain Your Camper We have all seen what can happen if you get a leak in your camper. Proper maintenance done in the Spring and the Fall can prevent costly repairs and depreciate your camper prematurely

• Conserve Electricity

- Run your Air Conditioner sparingly by using roof vents and fans.
- If you must use you're A/C, keep the camper closed up with curtains drawn and do avoid going in & out several times.
- Make sure to turn off any lights when they are not in use, or only run patio lights on a timer so they do not run all night.
- Run your water heater and refrigerator on propane when you can.
- Avoid Late Fees and penalties by paying invoices as they become due, as these can really add up.
- Timing your Payments This might not save actual money but can save on stress of larger payment. Space your payments out. There is no penalty for paying early. Get a Christmas Bonus, pay some on your site!

Package Policy: We are able to receive packages on your behalf at the Campground. Please refer to the Revised Policy Book for more details.

Site Payment Information:

Please remember that site deposits & payments must be up to date before the start of the camping season.

- CAN Cash rate is 0.70 CAN Check rate is 0.72
- Exchange Rate: One CN\$ is worth \$0.70 in US.
- This plan will be updated monthly.
- For example: If the US amount is \$266.75 divide this by \$0.70 = amount due in CN\$ \$381.07
- THIS RATE IS NOT VALID ON CAMPER SALES Payment Terms:
- EZ PAY PROGRAM: We have extended the sign-up period for the EZ PAY program, so that those who did not sign up in the fall may do so.
 - EZ PAY FINAL PAYMENT SCHEDULE:
 - 2nd payment: Monday, March 15, 2020
 - 3rd payment: Wednesday, April 15, 2020
 - 4th payment: Saturday, May 15, 2020
 - See the Policy Handbook for details
- Late Fees: a \$50 late fee will be applied to ANY contract that has NOT paid for their site in full by June 1st. Also, if this payment is late for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, your site rent will increase \$75. This applies to anyone who makes special arrangements to be paid AFTER June 1st. Regular missed payment fees and interest still apply.

Types of Payments

- Checks (preferred)
 - Post dated checks CANNOT be accepted.
 - Payments will be recorded and given a receipt the day the check is received.
 - A charge will be added for returned checks in addition to any late fees that may apply.
 - Checks in CAN currency will be subject to a different exchange rate.
 - Checks should be payable to:

- Credit card payments
 - We accept most major credit cards: Master Card, Visa, American Express, and Discover.
 - Card will be processed in US currency.
 Foreign credit card companies will use their own exchange rate for the conversion.

• Cash:

You will receive posted exchange (US\$) for every Canadian dollar. Simply divide the US amount by the posted exchange.
