END OF SEASON REMINDERS (Continued):

- Closing September Meter Bills The September meter reading has been completed and are ready to be paid. Here are some reminders about how the meter bills work:
 - Meters are read three times per season:
 - Opening The opening readings are typically done in early May and is a measure of the electrical usage from the previous closing reading until this reading. This will include anything used late in the season, over the Winter, and early Spring.
 - Mid-Season The mid season reading is typically done in mid-July and is a measure of the electrical usage from the opening reading through the midseason reading. There is a minimum \$30 charge for this.
 - Closing The closing reading is typically done in mid-September and is a measure of the electrical usage from the mid-season reading through the closing reading. There is a minimum \$30 charge for this.

<u>PARK UPGRADES</u> - Along with the usual park maintenance that our team performs on a daily basis, here is a short list of some upgrades for this year:

- With the assistance of Plattsburgh Creative Signs, we were able to install new signage throughout the park and in the office.
- We were able to get a fresh coat of paint on all of the buildings.
- As of this newsletter, the guys are working on remodeling the Laundry Room which should be completed this week.
