- Checking fluid level in all batteries and topping off as needed

- Storing golf carts inside until May 1st 2022

<u>Fishing Tip - Did You Know?</u> - Many fish, especially walleye and smallmouth bass, will track a crankbait and follow it right to the boat. Make

a habit of stopping your lure 2-3 ft. from the end of your rod when you're finished retrieving your cast and pause it for a second, especially in muddy water. Walleye especially will often strike a lure right at the boat if you let them.


