

MID-SUMMER GOLF CART SPECIAL:

With the border being closed and the uncertainty of when it will reopen, we have had a lot of concerns about golf carts. We have come up with a plan to take care of your cart and put it back in storage (INSIDE):



- Checking fluid level in all batteries and topping off as needed
- Charging batteries and having ready for storage
- Rinse off carts of any dust
- Storing golf carts inside until May 1st 2022 SPECIAL \$180.00 including tax Must be paid when signing contract

Bicycle Safety Tips - Biking has always been a fun hobby of mine and I take safety seriously. I found these Safety Tips and figured I would share them with our campers. PLEASE share them with the younger ones in your family as these rules will help keep them SAFE:

- Obey Traffic Signs Bicycles must follow the rules of the road like other vehicles. Stop Signs and speed limits are for bikers also!
- Always wear your helmet Cyclists 14 and younger are **REQUIRED BY LAW** to wear a helmet when operating a bicycle.
- Be alert to your surroundings:
 - Stop your bicycle when using your phone.
 - Make eye contact with other drivers
 - Look out for road hazards
- Use lights at night New York law requires a headlight and a red rear reflector or taillight.

Blue Haven Campground Policy Reminders: We have a lot of new families in the park this season. We want to remind everyone of a few of our

We have a lot of new families in the park this season. We want to remind everyone of a few of our policies here within the park. These guidelines have been set to ensure the SAFETY and ENJOY-MENT of ALL of our guests while at Blue Haven. We all need to follow them and here are just a few reminders:

GOLF CART POLICY

Operating Golf Carts in the Campground is a PRIVILEGE.

- Absolutely no gas powered golf carts, only electric powered are permitted.
- One cart is allowed per site and it must be registered with the Campground.
- You will be assigned a cart number and you must display that number as follows:
 - Numbers must be at least 3" high in a contrasting color
 - Displayed on two opposite sides (front/back OR side/side)
- There is a \$45 annual registration fee.
- Speed limit within the park is 5MPH for ALL vehicles, cars, golf carts, and bicycles.
- Golf Carts MUST be limited to the number of passengers the cart is designed to carry.
- NO ONE UNDER 16 YEARS OF AGE ARE ALLOWED TO DRIVE THE CART
- Golf Cart Chargers draw a significant amount of power, so please unplug your chargers when not in use, and especially in high electric use times.
- Golf Carts MUST have headlights and tail lights to operate at night.

For those who do not follow the guidelines above. We will take action(s) as necessary:

- 1st Offense: A warning will be issued.
- 2nd Offense: The Golf Cart will be grounded to your site for one (1) month.
- 3rd Offense: The Golf Cart will need to be removed from the Campground.
- NO EXCEPTIONS


Our team will be making sure that everyone is following the rules. For more information, please refer to page 22 of the Policy Handbook.

- If you see someone around a site you feel shouldn't be there, call the office so we can handle the issue.

July Meter Bills are Ready!

Please stop by the office to settle up for the July Meter Reading.

Site Payments are PAST DUE

With June 1st behind us, we still have a considerable amount of guests that have not paid for their sites in full for 2021. Please make

arrangements to get this caught up. It is not fair to the others that pay on time, not to mention there is added interest charges. Just as a reminder, here is a snip of the relevant payment information from the Policy Handbook outlining our site payment policy:

Late Fees

- All site rent is to be paid in full by June <u>1st.</u> This applies to all payment plans. If the site is NOT paid in full by June 1st, a late fee will apply, along with out standard missed payment fees/interest.
- Anyone who does NOT pay their site rent in full by June 1st for TWO (2) consecutive seasons, will see an increase in their seasonal site rent until paid on time.
- 2% interest of the unpaid site balance, will be charged to your account, on all contracts not paid by June 1st. Contracts and fees will continue to accrue interest monthly until the account is current.

ELECTRIC METERS & REIMBURSEMENT

Electric Meters

Meters will be read and bills will be prepared three times per season as follows:

- Opening Reading Usually read in early May which covers any usage from the previous Closing Reading
- Summer Reading Usually read mid-July which covers any usage from the Opening Reading through this Summer Reading minimum charges apply.
- Closing Reading Usually read mid to early September which covers any usage from the Summer Reading through this Closing Reading - minimum charges apply.
- Power bills <u>will not</u> be mailed, please stop at the Camp store to pay them.

Respect Other Campers in the Park

- Please do not park on other lots even if empty!
- Do not cross other's lots on foot or with a cart
- Respect the quiet hours as follows:
 - Weekdays 10PM to 9AM
 - Weekends and holidays 11PM to 10AM
- guests: Guests, extended Register your family, and friends **must** register at the Camp store. There is NO CHARGE to register prior or upon arrival. If they pass and have to be asked to register there will be a charge.

Propane Gas (LP) We Sell Propanel:

Propane can be ordered at the Camp store during business hours. Delivery and hook up is available for an additional fee:

- Are typically done around 12PM and 3PM
- Delivery fees include hooking up the tank and performing a leak check at that connection.

To get a tank filled:

Dont

- For tanks smaller than 100#, first bring the tank to the Camp Store to have the tank verified that it can legally be filled. There are several new laws currently in place that are posted in the office.
- Pay for the propane at the Camp store.
- Bring tag and bottle to the Shop located near the Camp store and have them filled.
- It will filled by 12:00PM and 3:00PM.
- The 100# tanks provided by the campground are property of our propane supplier and may NOT be removed from the park.

PACKAGE POLICY - We are not a post office. What we WILL receive (for a handling fee) must meet all of the following criteria:

- We must receive notification that the package is expected along with approximate size, weight, and expected delivery date.
- Package must meet UPS standards for size & weight.
- Packages must be addressed to a Blue Haven contracted customer.
- Any package that arrives that we need to use specialized equipment to unload will be subject to a service charge per package whether we are notified or not.

What we will NOT receive:

- Packages without notification of shipment.
- Packages addressed to customers whose name is NOT on an active Blue Haven site contract.
- Packages that arrive on a truck requiring special equipment to unload.
- Packages that arrive COD or have postage due.
- We will ONLY release packages to the person it is addressed to.
