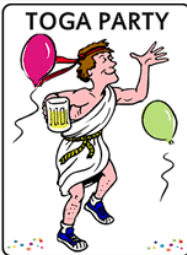


- **8pm - Midnight - Dance - JUST US** - children must be accompanied by parent or adult and are welcome until 9:30pm
