Policy Book Reminders - Every once in a while, we could all benefit from some gentle reminders - here are a few common infractionssee the complete policy book for more details:

- Golf Carts - Operating Golf Carts in the Campground is a Privilege, and we have set these guidelines to ensure safety for everyone in the Campground.
- You MUST be 16 years of age to drive a golf cart OR risk having the golf cart grounded to the site or even removed from the park.
- Golf Cart Passengers MUST be limited to the number of SEATED passengers the cart is designed to carry. NO Standing riders.
- Golf Carts MUST have headlights and tail lights to operate at night.
- Children's Play Area:
- The park is for children 12 and under and must be accompanied by an adult.
- Please no standing on the swings
- Playground closes at 11:00pm
- No loitering by anyone 13 and over
- Bicycles - please be sure ALL riders are educated on proper bike etiquette to include:
- Everyone 14 and under must wear a helmet.
- Obey stop signs and speed limits!
- No riding after dark unless you have a fixed headlight (NOT a flashlight).
- Ride on the right side of the road.
- Be aware of your surroundings!
- Privacy: Please respect the privacy of your neighbors by not walking across their site ESPECIALLY when they are not there. Please remind your children of this policy.
- CURFEW - Teens \& Children must be back at their site by 11 pm .
- Quiet Hours - everyone here deserves to be able to relax while here at camp, which is why we have quiet times as follows:
- Weekdays between 10 pm and 9 am
- Weekends \& holidays between 11pm \& 10 am
- Pets must be kept quiet, cleaned up after, and leashed at all times. Pets must not be allowed to annoy others in any manner, or be left unattended.

Golf Cart 5MPH Challenge There have been many reports of people speeding within the park. The speed limit is set to 5 mph for everyone's safety. I pose this challenge to EVERYONE who drives a cart - download onto your phone one of the many available speedometer apps and drive the park staying at 5 mph . This will give you a feel for just how slow this is. Yes, it is very slow, but we are at camp! Is anything here really that important that we need to always be rushing? SLOW DOWN and take in the sights! Take a look at some of the site decorations within the park. You might even catch a glimpse of some beautiful wildlife that you
